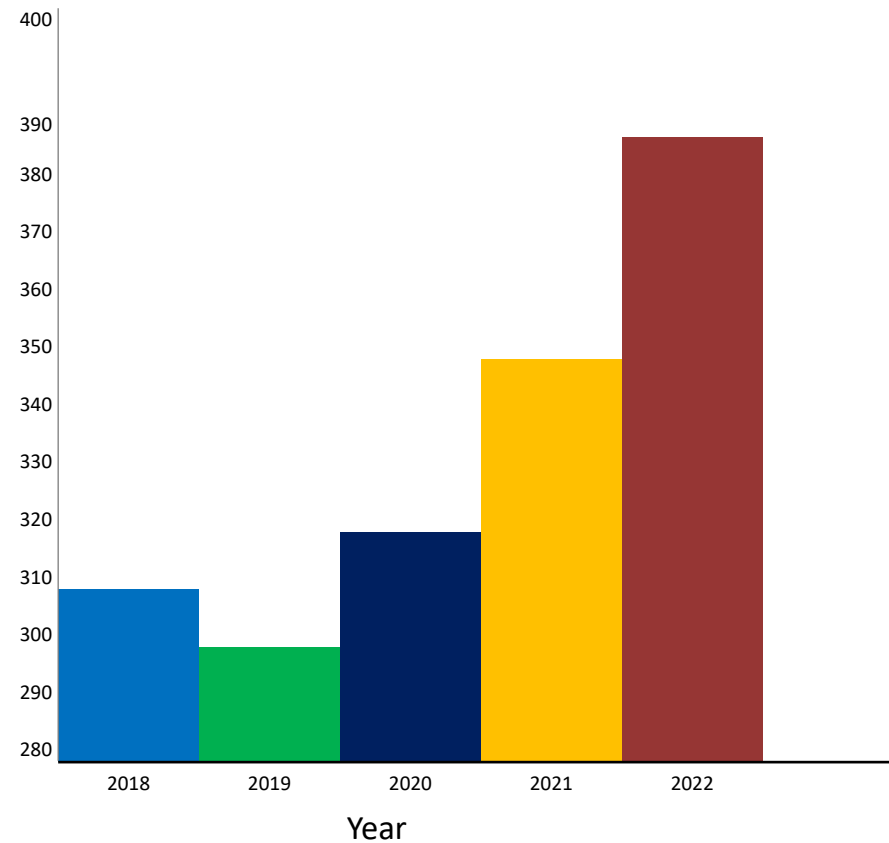

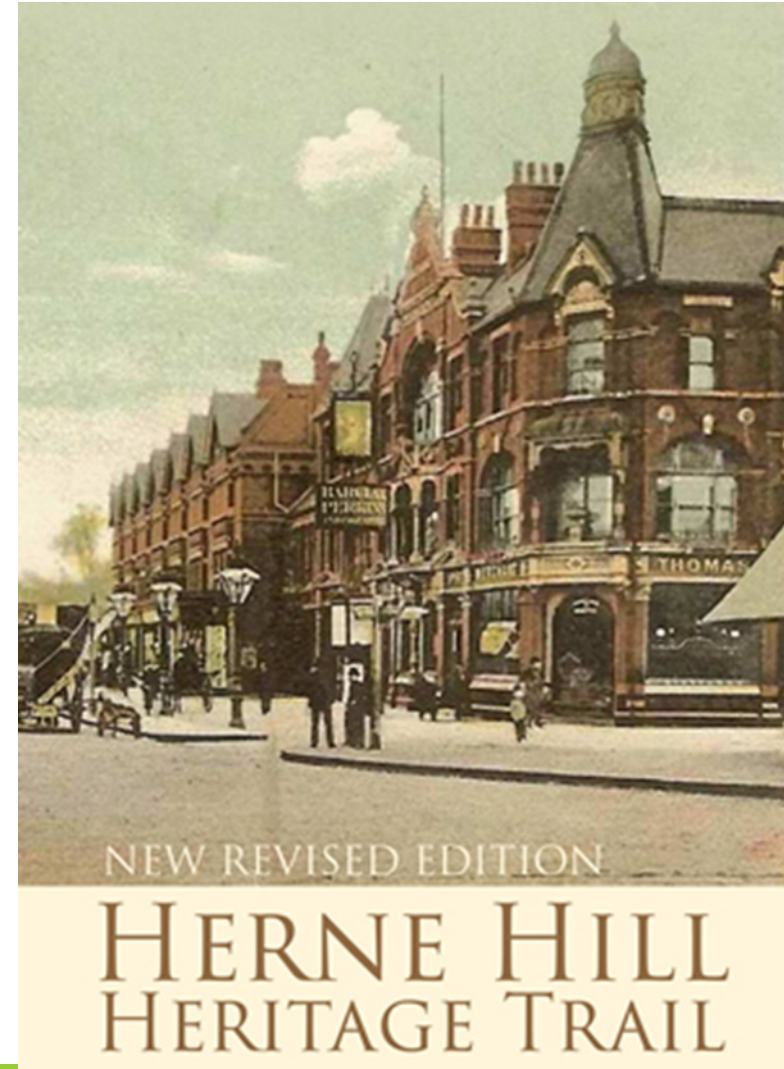
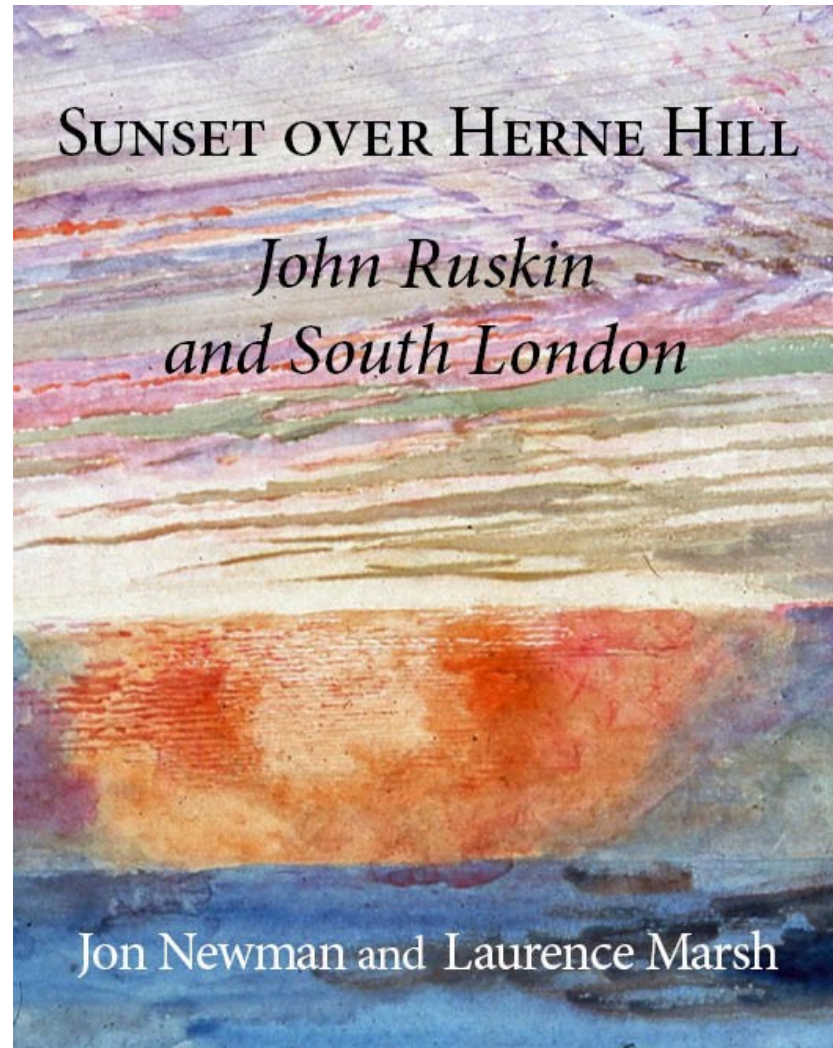

- 4) Making submissions to Southwark and Lambeth Councils re domestic properties where planning concerns were raised.

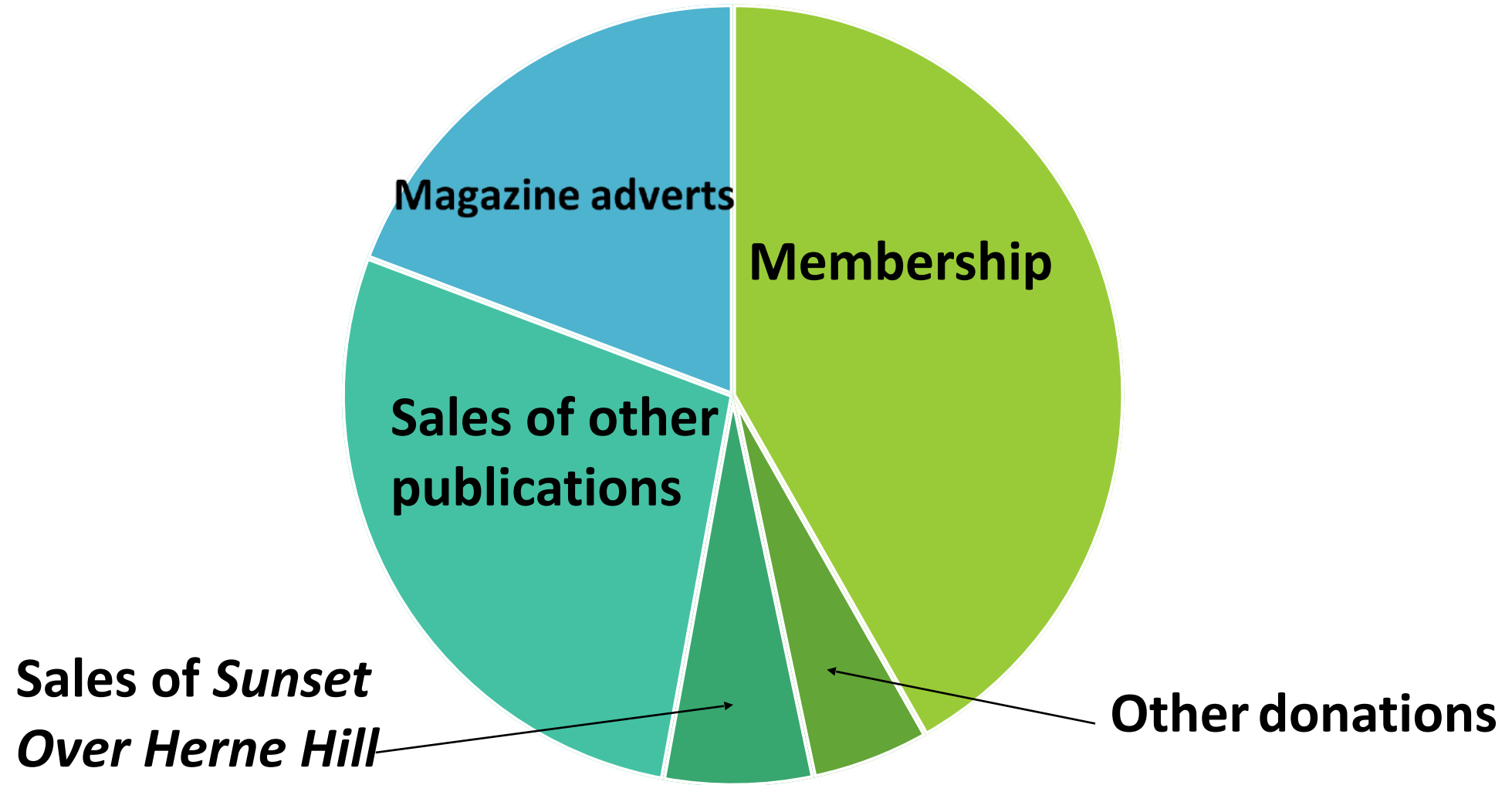

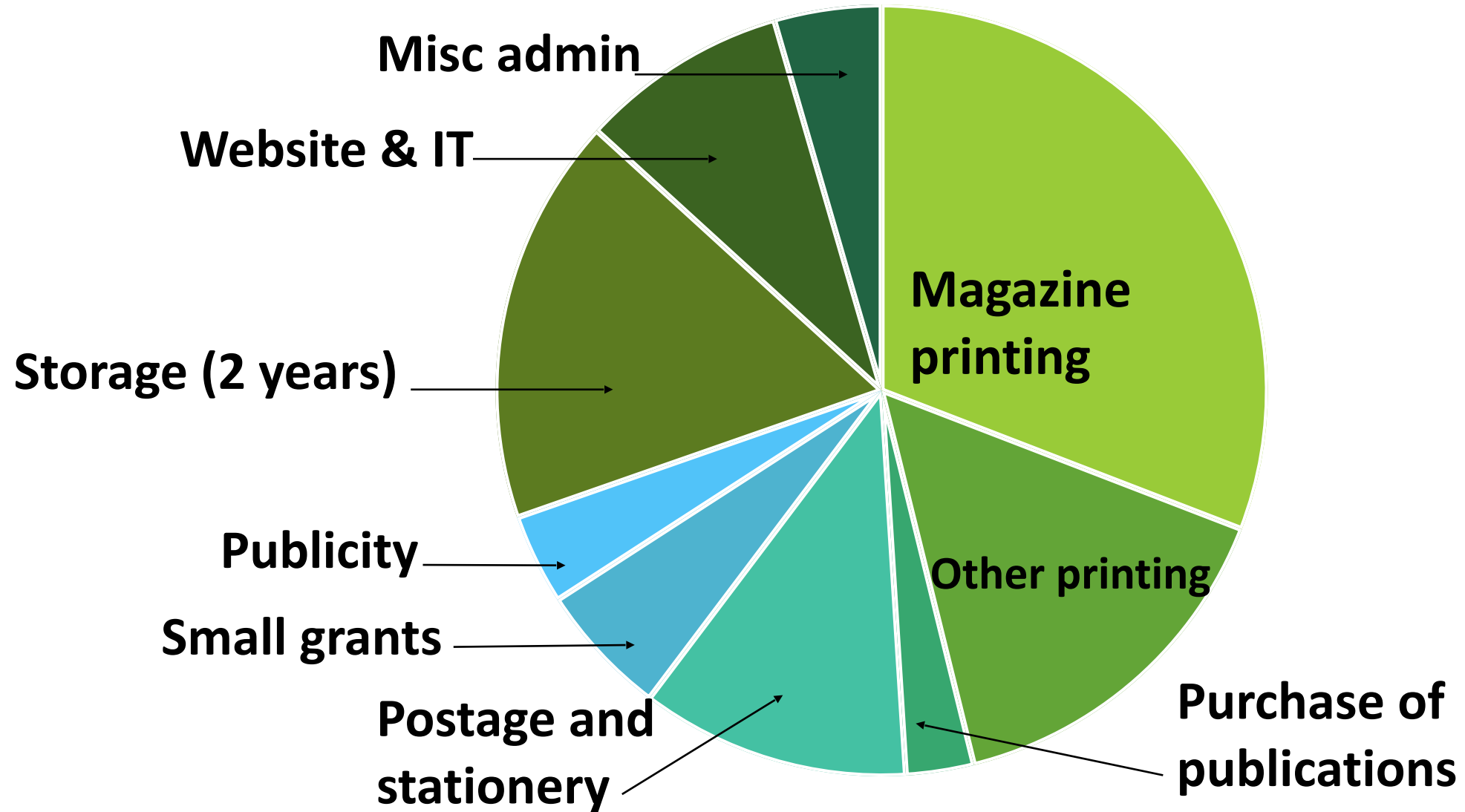
